

## **PGA OF MANITOBA ALCOHOL & DRUG POLICY**

## STROKE PLAY EVENT ALCOHOL POLICY

 The consumption of alcohol before or during any PGA of Manitoba stroke play event or Playing Ability Test is strictly prohibited. Violation of this policy is considered conduct unbecoming of a Member of the PGA of Canada/Manitoba, and swift penalty will be issued by the Tournament Committee and PGA of Manitoba office.

## **TEAM EVENT ALCOHOL POLICY**

- The PGA of Manitoba will allow the purchase of alcohol from the host facility during team
  events only. This policy will be reviewed following each event and if any issues arise (including,
  but not limited to, professional conduct, alcohol abuse, or liability), this policy will be revoked
  immediately.
- Penalties will be issued based on any Professional violating Liquor Laws and / or the <u>PGA Code</u> of <u>Professional Conduct and Safe Sport Policy</u>.
- This includes the following two events:
  - o PGA of Manitoba Pro Lady Tournament
  - o PGA of Manitoba Pro Pro Tournament
