



PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Point System

Points will be awarded in all Player of the Year events according to the size of the field and the place where the competitor finishes. For example the winner of a 50 person field would receive 50 points; second place would receive 49 points, down to last place which would receive 1 point.

In multiple round events, the points will be awarded as the number of participants multiplied by the number of rounds in the tournament. E.g. If there are 70 players in the PGA of Manitoba Championship, the winner would receive 140 points and last place 2 points. (1st 70 players x 2 rounds = 140 points, 2nd 69 players x 2 rounds = 138 points and so on.)

In 2026 the following events will be Player of the Year eligible:

- Spring Classic (1 day)
- Pro Partner (1 day)
- PGA Championship (2 days)
- Fall Championship (2 days)
