WHAT WE DO

The PGA of Manitoba Foundation Inc. is a charitable organization that has been established by a dedicated group of PGA of Manitoba golf professionals. The Foundation gives financially disadvantaged kids the opportunity to become involved in all the aspects of the great game of golf.



The PGA of Manitoba Foundation Inc. began with a group of local PGA of Canada professionals determined to make a difference in the golf community. As a part of the foundation, the Future Pros Program was created.

The Future Pros Program offers kids in Manitoba and northwest Ontario — who otherwise may not have the opportunity - to access to the

game of golf. The program provides them full junior membership at a local golf course, instruction, equipment, and all that is required to participate and enjoy the game.

By providing access to the game of golf, their world is opened up not only to the physical components of the game, but to the values it teaches us: respect, honesty, integrity, and perseverance. Future Pros participants become part of the golf community, which provides opportunity through the relationships they can develop.

We feel strongly that all kids in Manitoba deserve the chance to enjoy the game of golf and the community that surrounds it. Golf is a safe and active sport that fosters friendships and installs life-enhancing values.

WHO IS A FUTURE PRO?

A Future Pro is between 14 - 18 years of age who would not otherwise have the financial means to be able to play the game of golf. The Foundation works with local schools and their resource teachers to ensure kids that truly will benefit from the program apply.

HOW ARE THEY SUPPORTED?

Once accepted, students are provided with the full golf experience: junior membership to a golf club, instruction, and all the necessary equipment to play the game. A professional at each club is designated to provide guidance to each participant, while the foundation Executive Director stays in contact with the families and host clubs throughout the season.







WHAT IS THE **DURATION** OF THE PROGRAM?

The Future Pros Program accepts kids between the ages of 14 to 18 (grades 9 to 12) and will support them through to graduation, providing they participate in the game according to our criteria. These criteria are mutually agreed upon by the participant, their family members, and the foundation.

2018



In 2017 the Future Pros Program started with 8 kids at 4 golf clubs and in 2019, 15 kids began the program at 6 clubs around the city. St. Charles Country Club, Niakwa Country Club, Southwood Golf & Country Club, The Players Course, Breezy Bend Country Club and Kingswood Golf & Country Club have all hosted Future Pros! In 2020 we anticipate having 20 kids ages 14-18 enrolled in the Future Pros Program at Golf Clubs in and around Winnipeg.
