



The PGA of Ontario Awards Program Candidate for Membership of the Year Award

The PGA of Ontario Candidate for Membership of the Year Award is the highest honour the Association can bestow on a working Candidate for Membership whose total contributions to the game best exemplify the PGA of Ontario Candidate for Membership. This award embraces a wide range of services executed by the club professional.

Guidelines:

- Demonstration of outstanding qualities of leadership
- Well-regarded as a role model to other PGA of Ontario Golf Candidates for Membership.
- Candidates for Membership working in a proshop at golf course
- Must be a Candidate for Membership at the start of the year

Criteria:

1. Criteria to Measure

- a) Overall performance as a Candidate for Membership.
- b) Professional Development, learning and ambition.
- c) Service to the Zone and the Association.
- d) Leadership ability.
- e) Image and ability to inspire fellow Golf Professionals.

2. Selection Process

- a) Nomination should be based on the nominee's entire past experience.
- b) Achievements during the past three years should be emphasized.
- c) PGA of Ontario Awards Committee will select a recipient based on the criteria.

3. Eligible Categories

- a) All Candidate for Membership in good standing excluding the following: previous PGA of Canada Candidate for Membership of the Year Award winners, PGA of Canada National staff and PGA of Ontario Zone staff.

Note:

- In order to win a National Award, the individual member must successfully complete a criminal record check with BackCheck. After successfully completing the check, the cost will be reimbursed to the member.
- **Deadline to nominate: September 14, 2019**
- **Deadline to submit completed award package: September 16, 2019**
