- Attend all board meetings (approx. 6/year, hybrid of virtual and in-person), serve on committees of the board, and contribute from personal, professional or life experience to the work of the board
- Participate in additional strategy sessions, committee meetings, or special projects as needed
- Prepare for meetings by reviewing documents, contributing ideas, and offering thoughtful feedback
- Represent the PGA of Ontario in a professional and positive manner at events and functions
- Stay informed about the activities of the Association, the issues that affect the organization, and general trends in the environment in which the PGA of Ontario operates
