The Hunt features 27 holes of exceptional golf, renovated by renowned golf architect Dr. Michael Hurdzan, along with practice facilities that are among the best in Canada. The course has been recognized by *Score Golf* as the 9<sup>th</sup> best conditioned and 42<sup>nd</sup> best overall course in the country.
