

The Moe Norman Apprentice Professional of the Year Award is the highest honour the association can bestow on a working Apprentice Professional whose total contributions to the game best exemplify the PGA of Canada Apprentice Professional. This award embraces a wide range of services executed by the club professional.

Arguably the greatest ball striker in the history of golf, Moe Norman is one the game's true legends. Before turning professional in 1957, Norman won two-straight Canadian Men's Amateur Championships in 1955 and 1956. As a professional, he won the PGA Championship of Canada twice (1966, 1974) and captured the PGA Seniors' Championship of Canada a remarkable eight times—including a run of seven in a row from 1979-1985. He also represented at the World Cup in 1971. Norman was inducted into the Canadian Golf Hall of Fame in 1995 and the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame in 2006.

APPRENTICE PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR GUIDELINES:

- Demonstration of outstanding qualities of leadership
- Well-regarded as a role model to other PGA of Canada Apprentices Professional.
- Apprentice Professional working in a pro shop at golf course
- Must be an Apprentice Professional at the start the year

APPRENTICE PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR AWARD CRITERIA:

- 1. Criteria to Measure
 - a. Overall performance as an Apprentice Professional.
 - b. Professional Development, learning and ambition.
 - c. Service to the Zone and the Association.
 - d. Leadership ability.
 - e. Image and ability to inspire fellow Golf Professionals.

2. Selection Process

- a. Nomination should be based on the nominee's entire past experience.
- b. Achievements during the past three years should be emphasized.
- c. National Awards Committee will select a recipient based on the criteria.

3. Eligible Categories

- a. Must have won this award in your Zone for the current year to be eligible to win this National award
- b. All Apprentices Professionals in good standing excluding the following: previous PGA of Canada Apprentice of the Year Award winners, PGA of Canada National staff and PGA of Canada Zone staff.

NOTE:

- National Awards will be presented in conjunction with Canada Night at the PGA Show in Orlando, Florida.
- In order to win a National Award, the individual member must successfully complete a criminal record check with Sterling BackCheck at www.sterlingbackcheck.ca/PGA-of-Canada.
- After successfully completing the check, the cost will be reimbursed to the winner of the National Award.
- Deadline to submit November 7, 2019
