PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD



The Tex Noble Professional Development Award recognizes the PGA of Canada professional who is the model of life-long learning and continuing professional development. This award is designed to give special recognition to an individual PGA professional for outstanding and continuing contributions to professional development and continuing education.

In the late 1970s Tex Noble became the Education Director for the PGA of Canada, creating and managing an education system that was used for more than 20 years and became the envy of PGA's around the world. In 1983 he was hired as the PGA of Canada's General Manager and proved invaluable in helping to resolve various internal issues.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD GUIDELINES:

- Demonstration of outstanding qualities of leadership.
- Maintain a substantial record of service to the Association and the game of golf.
- Well-regarded as a role model in professional development and continuous education for fellow PGA of Canada Golf Professionals.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD CRITERIA:

1. Criteria to Measure
 - a. Contributions to National PGA of Canada education programs.
 - b. Contributions to Zone education programs and seminars.
 - c. Contributions and development of programs related to and benefiting education.
 - d. Contributions to building the image of both the PGA of Canada Golf Professional and the Association.

2. Selection Process

- a. Nomination should be based on a candidate's entire past experience and commitment for continuing one's contributions and assistance.
- b. Achievements during the past five years should be emphasized.
- c. National Awards Committee will select a recipient based on the criteria.

3. Eligible Categories

- a. Must have won this award in your Zone for the current year to be eligible to win this National award
- b. All Class "A" Members in good standing excluding the following: Life Professional, Retired Professional, previous PGA of Canada Professional Development Award winners, Past Presidents of the PGA of Canada (within the past 5 years), current PGA of Canada Board of Directors, PGA of Canada National staff and PGA of Canada Zone staff.

NOTE:

- National Awards will be presented in conjunction with Canada Night at the PGA Show in Orlando, Florida.
- In order to win a National Award, the individual member must successfully complete a criminal record check with Sterling BackCheck at www.sterlingbackcheck.ca/PGA-of-Canada.
- After successfully completing the check, the cost will be reimbursed to the member.
- Deadline to submit – November 7, 2018
