Requirements

- Comfortable with working under extreme weather conditions, including; hot and cold temperatures, high winds, extreme rainfalls, lightning
- Experience in the safe operation of motorized vehicles Golf Carts, Range Tractor

- Delegate tasks accordingly
- Perform Golf Operations duties bag storage, club cleaning, pulling clubs from racks, cars and placing on appropriate transportation, washing and drying dirty towels, maintaining lost and found, keeping back shop clean at all times, ensuring constant supply of divot mix
- Check that all Golf Operations Staff are wearing a complete uniform including name tag, radio & head set
- Ensure all Golf Operations Team Members have completed all assigned duties for the day
- Work alongside the Professional Staff with tournament day operations: lead Golf Operations Team through set up
- Staging of golf carts and golf bags in a neat and orderly fashion in the applicable areas
- Double check daily set up of cart staging, push carts, sand bottles etc.
- Keeping track of guest golf bags and making sure they are returned to the correct owner
- Maintain communication with the Professional Shop and starter
- All work stations to be kept in a clean manner and safe working condition
