Please find enclosed all the information required in order to register for the 2019 Playing Ability Tests. The PAT is just one step in the process of becoming a member of the PGA of Canada. **Applicants should review and fully understand all of the requirements and costs before registering.** The details are available at www.pgaofcanada.com – “Join”.

1. All Applicants are required to register with the National Office as an applicant and pay the National Registration fee.
2. Once registered you will be given web access to the PAT schedule and **must register online at least 4 days in advance prior** to attempting any of qualifying PAT's. A maximum of 5 PAT's may be attempted within a calendar year.
3. The PGA of Canada – Sask Zone will charge a PAT Fee of \$100.00 plus \$7.00 gst for each PAT attempt. Full payment of the entry fee must be made by the entry deadline. This can be done via credit card through Plastiq, through email transfer, or cheque mailed by the entry deadline. The NorthEast Open, and the Lobstick Open also have entry fees. It is the applicant's responsibility to enter these events in advance. One of the following must be completed to register as an Associate with the PGA of Canada:

Pass the PAT Entry Target Score :

36 holes (two 18-hole rounds) of stroke play golf. The PAT Target Score to register as an Associate Professional for Membership is two (2) times the course rating plus 20 strokes. Must pass the Class “A” PAT Target Score (two (2) times the course rating plus 15 strokes within 6 years and prior to becoming a Class “A” Member or must restart the program.

Pass the Class “A” Playing Ability Test (PAT) Target Score:

36 holes (two 18-hole rounds) of stroke play golf. The Class “A” PAT Target Score is two (2) times the course rating plus 15 strokes (see chart below). Must pass Class “A” PAT Target Score along with all core competencies prior to becoming a PGA of Canada Class “A” Member.
