With a membership of over 325 and a very active recreational golfing population, Mountain View Golf Club will generally service 20,000+ rounds per season. A typical golfing season starts mid to late April and will end near the first week in October.

Reporting to a Board of Directors and an Interim General Manager, the Director of Golf/Head Professional will oversee all aspects of the Golf Shop, Member services and all Golf Operations. The position is responsible to provide an exceptional golf experience and excellent customer service and programs to all members and guests.

The Director of Golf/Head Professional will work closely with the CGSA Superintendent and together form the Senior Management Team at Mountain View Golf Club.

- Procure and maintain appropriate stock for the Club's pro shop
- Provide club fitting services
- Develop and manage the annual Golf Operations budget, including monthly reporting to the Board
- Work with a part time book keeper and treasurer on all aspects of the Club's finances
- Participate as an active member of the Senior Management team
- Implement, enforce and maintain all Club policies
- Attend and assist with various Club committee meetings
