

PLAYER OF THE YEAR RANKINGS

The race for the Players of the Year offers members the opportunity to measure themselves against their colleagues over the course of the season, and will crown the Players of the Year in the following categories:

- o Overall Ranking
- o Senior
- o Women
- Head Professional
- Assistant

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Overall Ranking:
 - Be a member in good standing with the PGA of Québec;
- 2. Senior Ranking:
 - Open to any type of members;
 - Must be at least 50 years old or more as of the first round of a tournament.
- 3. Women's Ranking:
 - Open to any type of members;
 - Must be born as a woman or conforms to the gender policy of the PGA of Canada.
- 4. <u>Head Professional Ranking</u>: all members participating in this division must have one of the following types of member categories:
 - Head Professional
 - Head Teaching Professional
 - Owner / Operators
 - Chief Executive Officers
 - Chief Operating Officers
 - Executive Directors / General Managers
 - Manager of Golf Operations
 - Pro-Managers
 - Director of golf
 - Director of Operations
 - Director of Instructions
 - Head Golf Coaches who currently reside or work in Canada.

- 5. <u>Assistant Ranking</u>: all members participating in this division must have one of the following types of categories:
 - Class "A" Assistant Golf Coach
 - Class "A" Club Fitting Specialist
 - Class "A" Associate Professional
 - Class "A" Teaching Professional
 - Class "A" Assistant Professional
 - Class "A" Professional
 - Class "A" Sales Representative
 - Apprentice Professional

POINTS SYSTEMS

<u>Competitions Listing</u>: the competitions listing presented below consists of all the competitions associated to each category and each competition is linked to a number of points. The number of points is the winners' share and to know the points for each position following 1st place, please refer to the point distribution charts.

<u>Point Distribution Charts</u>: are the documents you must refer to so that you can get the points for each position at a competition. To visualize the correct chart, you must know the number of players registered in the competition. Following that step, you then pick the chart that applies to the number of players and look at the right column of points associated with that competition.

NOTES

- For all competitions, the number of points awarded to players who are tied for a specific rank will be shared equally between all tied players (e.g.: three players are tied for 3rd place, the points for 3rd, 4th and 5th place will be accumulated and divided by three);
- The committee may add / delete competitions during the current season if it deems it necessary;
- Here are the events that will count for each ranking from the **COMPETITION LISTING** above:

Overall: 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 - 8

Head Pro: 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 6 - 8

• Senior: 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 6 - 8

Assistant: 1 - 2 - 5 - 6 - 7 - 8

• *Women*: 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 - 7 - 8

Note: For the women's ranking, either tournament 3 or 7 will count but not both.

- For any ranking, only a number of events will count:

Overall: 5 out of 7

Head Pro: 5 out of 6

• Senior: 5 out of 6

Assistant: 5 out of 6

Women: 5 out of 7

- * Only the individual competition will be used to award points;
- ** Only the team competition (pro-pro) will be used to award points;
- Team competitions: both players from a team will be awarded the same number of points;
- For all competitions: all players are guaranteed last-place points.

PGA OF QUÉBEC TEAMS

The rankings will also be used to determine the PGA of Québec teams for the following PGA of Canada Championships:

- The four (4) leaders of the PGA of Québec's Assistants Professional Ranking, as of September 4,
 2025, will form the PGA of Québec Team that will represent us at the PGA of Canada Assistant Professional Championship.
- The four (4) leaders of the PGA of Québec's Head Professional Ranking, as of October 6, 2025, will form the PGA of Québec team that will represent us at the PGA Head Professional Championship of Canada or the PGA Head Teaching Professional Championship of Canada.
 - → Please note that from the 4 players making the team, only a maximum of two (2) players can be participating in the Head Teaching Professional Championship. Categories that can play in the Head Teaching Championship are: Head Teaching Professionals, Directors of Instruction, and Head Golf Coaches.

All players who qualify for a team will receive:

- Two golf shirts with the PGA of Québec logo;
- Registration fee refunded.

FINAL RANKINGS AND BURSARIES

The top finisher in each category, as of **October 6, 2025**, will win the honor of Player of the Year in their respective category. Please note that rankings will be deemed final as of **October 6, 2025**. No corrections (for whatever reason) will be made after that date.

<u>NOTE</u>: It is the responsibility of each member to verify the points awarded to them and to inform the PGA of Québec if an addition or correction needs to be made to their ranking.

Here are the amounts of the end-of-season bursaries that will be awarded per category:
